INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

ST. THOMAS MORE ROMAN CATHOLIC COLLEGE, DENTON

- 1. The name of the school is **St Thomas More RC College, Denton**.
- 2. The school was founded by and is part of the Catholic Church. The school is to be conducted as a Catholic School in accordance with Canon Law and the teachings of the Roman Catholic Church, and in accordance with the Trust Deed of the Diocese of Salford and in particular:
 - a) religious education is to be in accordance with the teachings, doctrines, discipline and general particular norms of the Catholic Church;
 - b) religious worship is to be in accordance with the rites, practices, discipline and liturgical norms of the Catholic Church;

and at all times the school is to serve as a witness to the Catholic faith in Our Lord Jesus Christ.

- 3. The school is a Voluntary Aided school.
- 4. The name of the governing body is "The governing body of St Thomas More RC College, Denton"
- 5. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a. 2 Parent governors
 - b. 1 Local Authority governor
 - c. 1 Staff governor
 - d. 1 Headteacher
 - e. 9 Foundation governors
 - f. 2 Co-opted governors
- 6. Total number of governors **16**.
- 7. Foundation governors shall be appointed and may be removed by the Bishop of Salford (or any other person exercising jurisdiction on his behalf).
- 8. This instrument of government comes into effect on 1st January 2019.
- 9. This Instrument of Government was approved by the Diocese of Salford on **03/12/2018** and made by order of Tameside Council on 28th January 2019.
- 10. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governor body (and the headteacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the appropriate religious body.
